To Whom It May Concern:

I am happy to write on behalf of Glimpse, which I have had the opportunity to observe since its earliest days, when its editors were still undergraduates. It has since that time become, in my view, the best publication dedicated to student experience abroad.

Thinking about this topic, I checked my shelves and found that I have kept many past issues of the magazine, not only because of the quality of the photographs – many taken by students abroad – but because the articles often provide material that I can use in discussion with students about their plans, or as a source of information, or as an illustration of some aspect of experience abroad. We have a very discerning student body here, and I have observed that Yale students find the level of the writing and reflection appealing. The aesthetic quality of the publication is, as you know if you have examined an issue, exceptionally good.

My colleagues in study abroad offices share my view, as I know from many conversations. In addition, I can speak as a member of the national leadership community in study abroad – I have served on the Board of NAFSA, on the Advisory Council of the Forum, and in other similar roles – when I say that for our community in higher education, a publication of this kind has real value. I do not hesitate to say that this is a venture well worth supporting, and one that is very useful to practitioners in the field of education abroad. Perhaps even more importantly, it serves as a testimonial document that is profoundly encouraging for many students contemplating spending time abroad.
